



King Middle School Halloween Activities and Guidelines

The following guidelines regarding Halloween activities have been developed by the Los Angeles Unified School District to allow students to participate in enjoyable, positive, and controlled activities, while addressing student safety.

- Students may wear costumes to school.
- **NO** costumes deemed to be offensive by King community standards, may be worn.
- Costumes may not cause a significant disruption to the school program, especially as in revealing costumes (French maids, nightwear, bathing suits, etc).
- No weapons or replicas of guns, knives, swords, or other dangerous objects (chains, bats, etc) are to be brought to school.
- No masks are allowed, nor any costumes that completely hide the identity of the student, like gorilla suits, "Scream" character or other masks, hoods, heavy make-up, etc.
- No costumes are allowed that would impair a student's vision or movement (ability to climb stairs, see peripherally, etc).
- All provisions regarding obscene material or prohibited substances remain in effect.
- School dress code is still in effect.

Remember, If you are in doubt about your costume, then it's probably not a good idea.
